17. Present Continuous

El *Present Continuous* describe acciones que ocurren en el momento en el que se está hablando (ej.: *We're watching TV.* – Estamos viendo la tele) o en un futuro cercano y planeado (ej.: *We're seeing Jim tomorrow.* – Mañana vamos a ver a Jim).

Lo usamos con las siguientes expresiones:

now, at the moment, these days, today, tonight, this weekend, next Monday, etc.

Para formar las oraciones afirmativas utilizamos la estructura:

sujeto + verbo *to be* conjugado + verbo con la terminación *-ing*, ej.:

I'm reading a book. – Estoy leyendo un libro.

He's reading a book. – Está leyendo un libro.

Para las negaciones añadimos *not* al verbo *to be*, ej.:

I'm not reading a book.

He isn't reading a book.

En las interrogaciones invertimos los términos según el esquema: verbo *to be* conjugado + sujeto + verbo con la terminación *-ing*, ej.:

Are you reading a book?

Is he reading a book?

Las respuestas cortas se forman: *yes/no* + sujeto + verbo *to be* conjugado, ej.:

Yes, I *am*. / No, I'm *not*.

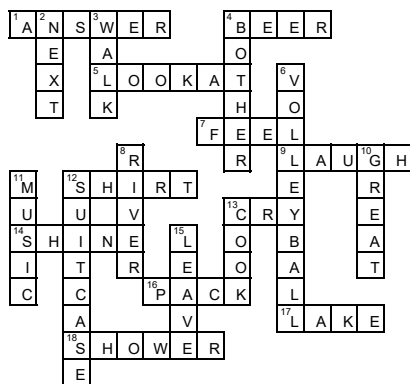
Crucigrama del capítulo 15.



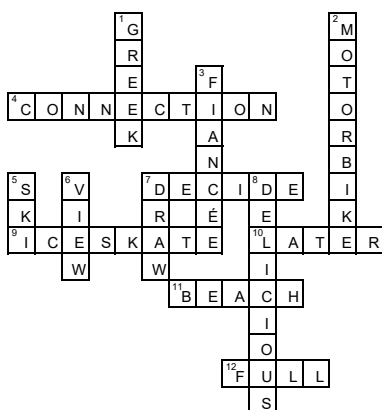

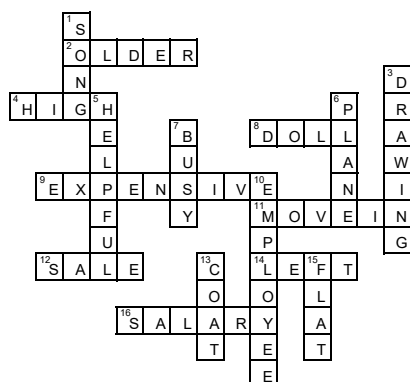

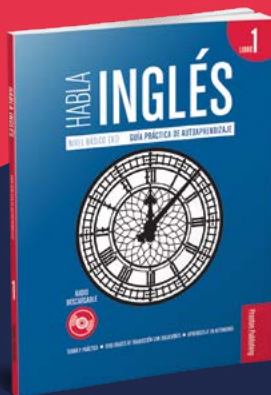
